**2023-2024 Season**

**Season Fee:** \$1,525 (Summer, Fall, State Cup – June 2023 to first week of February 2024)

**Fee covers:**

- Paid coach
- Fees for – tournaments, registration, referees, insurance, league play, scheduling, fields, equipment, scholarships, awards, administration and other expenses.
- Portion of pay to Director of Coaching, Technical Director and Goalkeeping Trainer

**Paying Season Fee**

When you complete the registration, there are two ways to pay, by check or credit card. You can also choose to pay in full or start a payment plan. Whether you choose to pay in full or opt for a payment plan, full payment or 1<sup>st</sup> installment must be made by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Please note that if you choose the payment plan, there will be a service fee and installment fee added to each installment.

- For check payor – please send the full payment to Bainbridge Island FC, PO Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. For a payment plan, please send 5 post-dated checks (with 1<sup>st</sup> check \$497 due on 6/1/2023 and four equal payment (\$259.50) checks for the remaining balance that are dated on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month starting July) to Bainbridge Island FC, P.O. Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. The installment amounts include service fee.

**Team Fee (collected by the team manager)**

Team related expense fee varies by team, which includes paid coach's travel expenses\* for summer tournaments and other team related expenses, such as first aid kit, team bench, team tent, equipment. These costs should be divided between all members of the team. Team fees can be between \$20-\$100 depending on the needs of the team.

\*Coach's travel expenses only apply to out-of-town tournaments and when accommodation is required. The expenses include accommodation and meal (breakfast only).

## **Registration Fee Refund Policy**

A \$250 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if request is made on or before June 30. A \$450 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if request is made on or before July 31. After July 31, the refund amount will be determined by individual cases.

## **Injury Release Policy**

If a player becomes injured participating in a Washington Youth Soccer sanctioned event during the season, the player is insured under secondary insurance via Washington Youth Soccer. Please visit the link below for instruction and application for medical claim.

If your player is unable to participate for more than 90 days and you have a doctor's note, you may be entitled to a pro-rated refund of the registration fee (assuming the fee has been paid in full). An injury release request needs to be submitted to [registrar@bifc.net](mailto:registrar@bifc.net) within 60 days of injury. ## **Uniform**

This season is the second year of new uniform cycle (each cycle is two years) and **Hummel** apparel is our uniform supplier. All new players are required to purchase a complete uniform kit. The cost for the uniform kit is approximately \$150-\$170 (depending on sizes) plus tax/shipping. Returning players will have the options to purchase individual uniform pieces.

### **The uniform kit includes:**

2 jerseys (blue & white), 2 pairs of shorts (blue), 2 pairs of socks (blue), 2 training jerseys (blue)

### **Optional:**

Warm up jacket, warm up pants, duffel bag or backpack

**Assigned jersey number:** You will receive your assigned jersey number and ordering instructions.

## **Volunteer/Fundraiser Obligations**

BIFC is a volunteer-based organization and each member is obligated to a 6-hour volunteer commitment to BIFC. Help in areas as fields maintenance and set up, public relations, team manager, club events organization, board member, general volunteer. Further opportunities may come available in the future and will be announced to the membership.
