Season Fee:

Summer & Fall (July – November)	\$950

Fee covers:

- Paid coach
- Fees for tournaments, registration, referees, insurance, league play, scheduling, fields, equipment, scholarships, awards, administration and other expenses.
- Portion of pay to staff members.

Paying Season Fee

When you complete the registration, there are two ways to pay, by check or credit card. You can also choose to pay in full or start a payment plan. Whether you choose to pay in full or opt for a payment plan, full payment or 1st installment must be made by July 1st, 2024. Please note that if you choose the payment plan, there will be a service fee and installment fee added to each installment.

 For check payor – please send the full payment to Bainbridge Island FC, PO Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. For a payment plan, please send 3 post-dated checks (with 1st check \$402 due on 7/1/2024 and two equal payment (\$277) checks for the remaining balance that are dated on the 1st of each month starting August) to Bainbridge Island FC, P.O. Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. The installment amounts include service fee.

<u>Team Fee</u> (collected by the team manager)

Team related expense fee varies by team, which includes paid coach's travel expenses* for summer tournaments and other team related expenses, such as first aid kit, team bench, team tent, equipment. These costs should be divided between all members of the team. Team fees can be between \$20-\$100 depending on the needs of the team.

*Coach's travel expenses only apply to out-of-town tournaments and when accommodation is required. The expenses include accommodation and meal (breakfast only).

Registration Fee Refund Policy

A \$190 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if request is made on or before July 15. A \$350 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if request is made on or before August 15. After August 15, the refund amount will be determined by individual situation.

Injury Release Policy

If a player becomes injured participating in a Washington Youth Soccer sanctioned event during the season, the player is insured under secondary insurance via Washington Youth Soccer. Please visit the link below for instruction and application for medical claim.

If your player is unable to participate for more than 90 days and you have a doctor's note, you may be entitled to a pro-rated refund of the registration fee (assuming the fee has been paid in full). An injury release request needs to be submitted to <u>registrar@bifc.net</u> within 60 days of injury. <u>Uniform</u>

This season is the first year of the new uniform cycle (each cycle is two years). We will be using <u>Adidas</u> apparel as our new uniform supplier. All players are required to purchase a complete uniform kit. The cost for the uniform kit is approximately \$200 (depending on sizes) plus tax/shipping.

The uniform kit includes:

2 jerseys (blue & white), 1 pair of shorts (blue), 1 pair of socks (blue), 1 training jersey, 1 warm up jacket

Assigned jersey number: You will receive your assigned jersey number and ordering instructions.
