- Portion of pay to staff members.

Paying Season Fee

When you complete the registration, there are two ways to pay, by check or credit card. You can also choose to pay in full or start a payment plan. Whether you choose to pay in full or opt for a payment plan, full payment or 1st installment must be made by July 1st, 2025. Please note that if you choose the payment plan, there will be a service fee and an installment fee added to each installment.

• For check payor – please send the full payment to Bainbridge Island Youth Soccer Club, PO Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. For a payment plan, please send 3 post-dated checks (with 1st check \$447 due on 7/1/2025 and two equal payment (\$292) checks for the remaining balance that are dated on the 1st of each month starting August) to Bainbridge Island Youth Soccer Club, P.O. Box 10949, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110. The installments include service fee.

Team Fee (collected by the team manager)

Team related expenses vary by team, can include first aid kit, team bench, team tent, equipment etc.. These costs should be divided between all members of the team.

Registration Fee Refund Policy

A \$220 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if a request is made on or before July 15. A \$375 fee (per player) will be deducted from all registration refunds if a request is made on or before August 15. After August 15, the refund amount will be determined by individual situation.

Injury Release Policy

If a player becomes injured participating in a Washington Youth Soccer sanctioned event during the season, the player is insured under secondary insurance via Washington Youth Soccer. Please visit the link below for instruction and application for medical claim.

If your player is unable to participate for more than 90 days and you have a doctor's note, you may be entitled to a pro-rated refund of the registration fee (assuming the fee has been paid in full). An injury release request needs to be submitted to registrar@bifc.net within 60 days of injury. Injury release request form can be found at https://www.bifc.net/parent-player-resources.

Uniform

This season is the second year of the new uniform cycle (each cycle is two years). We continue to use **Adidas** apparel as our uniform supplier. All **new** players are required to purchase a complete uniform kit. The cost for the uniform kit is approximately \$200 (depending on sizes) plus tax/shipping. For returning players, there is no need to purchase a set of uniform kit, but individual pieces of uniform kit can be purchased if needed.

The uniform kit includes:

2 jerseys (blue & grey), 2 pairs of shorts (blue & grey), 2 pairs of socks (blue & grey), 1 training jersey (navy).
